



The LI2Day Walk Scholarship Guidelines:

LI2Day Scholarship: This is a \$2,500 scholarship that will be awarded to 5 graduating seniors in Nassau and Suffolk Counties. The student must be a survivor of breast cancer and/or other women's cancers, or reside with a parent or guardian who is a survivor of breast cancer and/or other women's cancers, or have resided with a parent or guardian who has passed from breast cancer and/or other women's cancers. **ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED. Names of the Scholarship recipients will be posted on our website (www.li2daywalk.org) after May 15, 2020.**

The awarding of these scholarships will be based on an evaluation of the following criteria:

1. Content and completeness of Application, including school, community, and outside activities
2. Quality and content of Personal Statement (this criteria is very important) (One page or less)
3. Letter of Recommendation
4. High School educational effort and definite plans for 2019 – 2020 Academic Year

Please include the following check-list with your application:

To be eligible for this scholarship, Applicant must be:

- A resident of Nassau or Suffolk County, New York,
- Enrolled in high school full-time,
- A graduating senior, and
- Have applied and received acceptance to either a two- or four-year College or University, and
- Is a survivor** of breast cancer and/or other women's cancers, **reside** with a parent or guardian who is a survivor of breast cancer and/or other women's cancer or resided with a parent or guardian who passed from breast cancer and/or other women's cancer.

THE APPLICANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THAT ALL ITEMS LISTED BELOW ARE SUBMITTED AS ONE (1) PACKAGE AND POSTMARKED BY APRIL 1, 2020.

- Completed application and personal statement (ONE PAGE OR LESS)
- One (1) letter of recommendation
- Copy of official high school transcript
- Proof of acceptance in educational program for 2020-2021 academic year
- Extracurricular typed written list

These scholarships are **NOT** need-based and may be awarded to anyone who applies, based solely on the decision of the Scholarship Committee of the LI2Day Walk. **Emphasis is placed on how well the essay addresses how the applicant was affected by breast cancer and/or other women's cancer.** Recipients, their parents and/or guardian will be invited to a scholarship awards brunch in May 2020 to receive their scholarship award.
